BUILDING EVACUATION

General Student and Staff instructions for building evacuation plans

- 1. Leave everything on or under desk in classrooms, except purses, or valuable items.
- 2. Remain seated until dismissed by the teacher one row at a time. Each teacher shall select one student who will act as a leader and will lead the way to the proper exit and assembly at each drill.
- 3. Each class shall leave the classroom and building in single file.
- 4. No talking or visiting during any type of emergency drill. This will make it possible for staff and leaders to give verbal instructions if needed.
- 5. <u>NEVER RUN</u> move rapidly but do not run, push, or shove.
- 6. Staff members must take grade books for roll check. Leave the classroom door unlocked but closed.
- 7. All classes must assemble in their designated areas and remain together as a class.
- 8. Remain in your assembly area until called to return to the building. Then return directly to your original classroom. No stopping at restrooms, water fountains, etc.
- 9. Each teacher must post emergency procedures in their classroom.
- 10. Teachers with students who are physically challenged should ensure understanding of proper evacuation procedures.
